BTEC Child Development student visit to Wildground Nursery, Preschool and Infant School

Your child has been invited to attend a trip to Wildground Nursery, Preschool and Infant School on Friday 28th February 2025.

As part of their Component Three preparation, the class will be learning about how to support young children as they learn in an Early Years Setting. This includes children who have specific needs, disabilities and children with other various social and emotional challenges. Wildground has amazing special educational needs support from Nursery age right up to Key Stage 1. They also have a Resource Provision Centre which caters for children who have specific learning needs.

A visit such as this will show the students how the skills we discuss theoretically in the classroom are actually put into practice in an EYS. It will also improve their knowledge and understanding for when they have to write about these things in their written examination in May.

On Friday 28th February, we have a double Child Development lesson periods 4 and 5 which means the students will not miss any other subjects. We will travel to Wildground in the school minibus at the start of period 4 and then return to school just after the end of the normal school day.
