## Year 8 - Chalke History Trip

We are pleased to offer Year 8 students the opportunity to visit the Chalke History Festival in Salisbury on **Monday, 23rd June 2025**. This is a fantastic chance for our young historians to deepen their understanding of historical events and themes. The festival will explore the following topics in greater detail:

- D-Day
- History of Infectious Disease
- Survivors: The Lost Stories of the Last Survivors of the Atlantic Slave Trade
- The Stalin Affair: Roots of the Cold War
- The French Revolution
- What is History Now?
- Tudor Women
- Cold War Protest Movements
- Daily Life in the Iron Age
- The Time Traveller's Kitchen
- The Rise of the Mounted Knight
- WW2 Trench and SOE Training Camp

We have secured **45 tickets** for this event. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated via a ballot. If your child would like to attend, please log in to the **Arbor app** and provide consent. If using a mobile phone, turn your device to **landscape mode**, scroll to the **bottom right** of the page, select **Trips**, and a new screen will display the trip offer. Choose the trip and follow the instructions to provide consent.

The total cost of the trip is £40.00, which covers entry to the festival. This is a wonderful opportunity for keen historians to further enrich their love of the subject. We plan to leave Noadswood at 8:30 am and aim to return to school at approximately 4:30 pm, traffic permitting.

We reserve the right to cancel the trip if numbers are too low. In this instance, anyone who has already paid will receive a full refund. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated through a fair ballot, and those who are unsuccessful will also receive a full refund.

The deadline to sign up is **Friday**, **4th April**, **at 4:00 pm**. If your child is in receipt of **Pupil Premium** (or has been eligible for **Free School Meals** in the past six years), financial support may be available.
